### **Price Named to Significant House Committees**

#### **Representative Price appointed to Natural Resources and Culture, Recreation, & Tourism Committees**

Today, Speaker of the House, Joe Straus, in announcing committee assignments, appointed State Representative Four Price to key House committees which have statewide impact on developing Texas' policy on natural resources, water, parks and wildlife, and tourism. These committees are the Natural Resources Committee and the Culture, Recreation & Tourism Committee.

"I am very pleased and honored to have been selected to serve on these highly coveted committees. I asked to serve on these committees because of the vital role they play in shaping Texas' future," Representative Price said. "Water is important to my constituents and to the entire state especially given the growth that Texas is experiencing. I am glad that I have a major seat at the table to help advocate that all Texans, including water rich and predominantly rural areas, are treated fairly when it comes to our precious water resources," Price further said.

"Likewise, I am delighted to serve on the committee that will make major policy decisions regarding legislation involving our 100 plus diverse state parks, our abundant wildlife, our rich historic and cultural sites, and the promotion of our dynamic tourism industry. All of these items significantly contribute to not only our state and local economies but also to who we are as Texans. Having the right policies in place is vital to our entire state." Representative Price said. Statistically, the tourism industry directly generates over \$22 billion into the Texas economy each year and employs more than a half million Texans. Additionally, spending by state visitors creates jobs and tax revenues for communities of all sizes.

Representative Price is the only state representative from the Panhandle selected to serve on the eleven member House Committee on Natural Resources and also the only member from the region serving on the Culture, Recreation & Tourism Committee.
